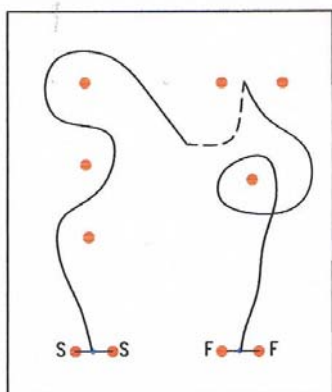

Winter Autotesting School 2008/09

750 Motor Club (Scotland) invite you to participate in a 5-event autotest series. The series is designed to take newcomers to the sport, up to a more advanced level of driving skill. Each event will introduce new manoeuvres, for which, instructions and demonstrations will be given. One of the events will run alongside an association championship event, which will allow participants see the experts and their cars in action. It is an introduction to an exciting but low cost form of motorsport. Experience autotesters are welcome too.

Don't worry if you miss an event, help will be at hand for catching up!

What is autotesting?

Competitors are required to drive around a course defined by cones. The route map may require some reversing as well as driving forwards. Penalty points are accumulated for every second of time taken to complete the course and further penalties are given for errors such as striking a cone. Each event will consist of a number of tests and each competitor will have 2 runs at each test with their best time to count for results. At the end of the event the competitor with the fewest penalty points is the winner.

A standard road car can be used, smaller ones are more manoeuvrable so have an advantage. The car need not be taxed or MoT'd but mechanical soundness and safety features such as brakes and steering are checked before the event. Many serious autotesters use cars worth less than £200.

Typical costs: 12-month club membership £12.50; Event entry fee £7.

Competitors must be minimum of 15 years old and does not need to hold a driving license, subject to carrying an experienced passenger.
